



Dear KISD Parents.

Our primary responsibility is to keep students safe while they are in our care. As such, and in keeping with Kenedy ISD's practices to respond to COVID-19, we are notifying you that Two Kinder students, One First grade student, One Third Grade student and One Fifth Grade student have been confirmed to have COVID-19 at the Elementary campus today. These students have been at school or at a school event and may have had contact or prolonged exposure with your child. Due to privacy requirements, we will not be releasing the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her. In an abundance of caution, all areas that may be affected have been deeply sanitized.

Please be aware that any of the following symptoms indicate a possible COVID-19 infection:

- Temperature of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat;
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (or, for students with a chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline);
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain; or
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

We require anyone in the Kenedy ISD community who is confirmed to have COVID-19 to please notify our school by contacting me via email at fgibson@kenedyisd.com. We also provide COVID-19 testing for students, staff, and board members, at no cost. If you would like to make an appointment for a COVID-19 test for your child, please contact your school nurse via email at esalais@kenedyisd.com or kzidek@kenedyisd.com.
